# RACE ENTRIES

## 04.1 RIDER REGISTRATION

All registrations for Enduro or E-Enduro UCI World Cup and Open Racing categories will need to be made on the [www.ucimtbworldseries.com](http://www.ucimtbworldseries.com) website.

Further details will be confirmed in the upcoming months on the process to make entries. .

### UCI Enduro World Cup

In order to race in the UCI Enduro World Cup, riders must either be on an official UCI Enduro or Mixed Team or have the minimum required number of Global Ranking points or direct upgrades.

#### **Minimum Points:**

- Men Elite: 125 points
- Women Elite: 125 points
- Men U21: 75 points
- Women U21: 50 points

### Open Racing

There is no pre-qualification requirements, however, please refer to the Race License section for specific requirements as per the French Federation.

Riders who do not have a UCI license issued by their National Federation (for example, French Federation Cyclisme) **must show a medical certificate** issued within the last year. If riders do not have a medical certificate, [the medical centre](#) in Loudenvielle will be able to issue the medical certificate at a cost of €26.

Upon providing your medical certificate at rider confirmation, riders will need to pay €10 for race insurance.

Entries are offered on a first come first served basis.

There will also be the addition of a Youth Category for riders aged 15 – 17.

For the U18 riders: parents must provide a parental consent.

For information on how to qualify into the UCI Enduro World Cup, please refer to Chapter 2 of the [2024 Enduro Rulebook](#).

## 04.2 RACE LICENCES

### UCI World Cup

All riders must hold a valid (in date) UCI licence issued by their National Federation. Riders will be required to present their licenses at rider confirmation.

### Open Racing

**Active / valid UCI ID licences are required for riders to be eligible to collect UCI Enduro World Cup** qualifying points. Your UCI Number must be added to your rider account.

For the U18 riders: parents must provide a parental consent.

### International riders

International riders must have UCI licenses issued by their own national cycling federations.

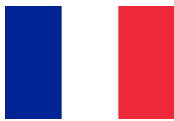
If an Event is relocated and/or rescheduled, the entries will be automatically transferred to the new date and/or location.

## 04.10 TRAINING

### TRAINING SCHEDULE

#### **Thursday 5th September**

09:00 – 17:00 : Practice – All Riders

Official training will take place on **Thursday 5th September** for both Enduro and E-Enduro.

All riders and team staff must display their handlebar number during training sessions. As per the 2024 Enduro Rulebook (Article 1.1.5), only Official UCI Enduro Teams will be provided team plates to allow team staff on course during practice only.

Race stages are closed during official training to all racers but media and official Whoop UCI Enduro World Cup Team staff.

Any rider training without a plate or outside the official schedule will be disqualified.

## 04.11 SHUTTLES

All riders will get lift access for both practice and race.

For practice: private shuttles also allowed on public roads. No shuttles provided by LOC.

## 04.12 TIMING CHIP COLLECTION

Timing system: Chronorace

All riders are responsible for the return of their transponder in the finish area. Any non-returned transponder will be invoiced 100 euros.

## MEDICAL

The UCI have a [concussion protocol](#) & we will, in conjunction with the LOC appointed medical team, be applying this protocol across all disciplines during training & races.

Any rider who has an incident which could result in a head injury / concussion & is then asked to undergo a concussion assessment by a member of the event medic team must comply with this request. Likewise, any rider or team manager who suspects a concussion should refer themselves or their athlete to the event medical team as soon as possible. A positive diagnosis of concussion by a medical professional may result in that athlete being withdrawn from competition.
