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02. RACE ENTRIES

03.1 RIDER REGISTRATION

All registrations for Cross-country Olympic and Cross-country Short Track World Cup categories will need to be made on the <u>www.ucimtbworldseries.com</u> website by all UCI Elite teams, UCI teams and National Federation teams.

All privateer riders must register with their entry with their federation first before proceeding with payment.

Qualification criteria can be found here.

03.2 RACE LICENCES

All riders must hold a valid (in date) UCI licence issued by their National Federation.

03.3 ENTRY FEE'S

UCI Cross-Country World Cup: € 150.00

All entry fees must be paid online at <u>www.ucimtbworldseries.com</u> before rider confirmation. No plates can be collected without payment. No cash or card payment is available.

03.4 RIDER CONFIRMATION & PLATE COLLECTION

LOCATION – Next to the Underground Teams Area, next to EXPO A. See the map for the correct location (coming soon).

ACCREDITATION & DISCLAIMERS

03.5 TEAM AND RIDER EVENT ACCREDITATION

Season passes will be distributed in Mairiporã. However, each rider and member of staff will be issued a bracelet which must be worn to enter the event arena and team areas.

03.6 INSURANCE

Personal insurance coverage is not provided by the WBDS/Organisers. Racers are responsible for securing their own accident, rescue, health, travel, property and liability insurance.

Racers should have the following insurance coverage:

- Bodily injury (in and out-patient hospital expenses and medical care, emergency rescue and medical transport costs, permanent disablement, death) and material damages (loss of earnings) in case of accident in the course of the Event or during training
- Third-party liability insurance for material damage or bodily injury caused to others in the course of the Event or during training.

03.7 DISCLAIMER AND LIABILITY RELEASE

Racers voluntarily assume full and complete responsibility for all risks associated with participating in the Event and for any injury, accident or damage that may occur during their participation in the Event, including by way of example and not limitation: (a) travelling to and from the Event; (b) falls; (c) mechanical failures of equipment; (d) collisions with other participants, spectators and fixed or moving objects; (e) the effects of weather, including temperature extremes; (f) use of chairlifts, gondola or shuttle vehicles; (g) traffic accidents; (h) trail and road conditions; and (i) the negligence of themselves and/or others.


MAPS

04.1. <u>VENUE MAP</u>








04.2. CROSS-COUNTRY COURSE MAP

ON-SITE RACE LOGISTICS

04.1 TRAINING

TRAINING SCHEDULE: As per the schedule.

All riders must display their handlebar number during training sessions.

All UCI teams and select National Federations will receive season team plates. Season plates are for the 2024 season, any replacement plates will incur a fee.

Team plates have been pre-allocated and will not exceed the following allocation.

- UCI Elite MTB Team 2 Team Plates
- UCI MTB Team 1 Team Plate
- National Federations 1 Team Plate

Any federations, not pre-allocated a plate can request a team plate at rider confirmation.

The course will be <u>closed</u> for TV inspection on a day to be confirmed in the schedule. The course will be <u>closed</u> for UCI inspection on a day to be confirmed in the schedule.

04.2 TIMING CHIP COLLECTION

Timing system: <u>Chronorace</u> Racers must carry their Timing Chips on their bike.

Timing Chips can be collected between 90 - 30 minutes before the start of each race and available from the Timing tent on the day of the race.

All riders are responsible for the return of their transponder in the finish area. Any non-returned transponder will be invoiced 100 euros.

04.3 PRIZE MONEY COLLECTION

Prize money will be paid by the local organising team. Please follow the below process to claim your prize money if you place Top 10 in Elite Men and Women XCC and XCO, as well as Top 10 in U23 XCO only.

Athletes who have an award to receive should look for Carla Martins, financial director, in the Rider confirmation room, Friday, Saturday and Sunday (April 19 to 21). **Prize money is available for collection for 60 minutes after the conclusions of the podium ceremony** for the race.

All Prize money will be paid in Brazilian Real CASH.

04.4 ANTI-DOPING

Anti-Doping location: Location is next to the RIDER CONFIRMATION. Follow the signs and go up to the first floor via the stairs or elevator.

WBDS will follow all <u>ITA</u> rules, protocols and procedures. It is the responsibility of all riders, teams, coaches to read and follow all advice and documents provided by ITA.

TEAM PADDOCK PROCEDURES

05.1 TEAM AREA ACCESS

There will be two team areas, one at the Grande Hotel Club and the other at the underground Team's area. There will be an exclusive access route to the Start, through the underground team area.

You will need to detail the following.

- Exact arrival time
- Vehicle registration plate (restricted to 2 vehicles only for each team)
- Names of staff arriving to set up team paddock

Athletes and teams going to the event location by car must follow the signs along the path that will indicate GRANDE HOTEL - WORLD CUP VENUE. Please refer to the access venue maps for the routes of entry into the venue.

All teams must arrive by **Thursday 18th at 12:00 (local time)**, any late arrivals will incur a €1,000 penalty fine.

Any teams wishing to cancel their paddock space must inform <u>cycling.teams@wbd.com</u> by 17:00 Wednesday 17th April.

Paddock Arrival: Please ensure you stick to your arrival slot.

For athletes and team members who ride bikes, we will have a bike path connecting the MTB Village to the World Cup venue.

05.2 ADDITIONAL TEAM AND ATHLETE PARKING

Athletes and teams will be the only ones who will have access to the World Cup venue by car (2 per team, 1 per individual rider). There will be an exclusive parking lot with a concierge with entry control and all cars must have stickers glued to the windshield. The LOC will provide parking stickers upon arrival.

05.3 TEAM DE-RIG AND DEPARTURES

All UCI Teams with elite competitors will not be able to depart or de-rig their spaces any earlier than 16:00 on Sunday.

Should your team only have U23 riders competing on Saturday, please ensure early departure approval is granted by WBD Sports first or you will risk being charged the €1,000 early departure penalty fee.

006 VENUE LOGISTICS

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TRAVEL & ACCOMMODATION

06.1. INTERNATIONAL AIRPORTS Araxa airport (code AAX) receives direct flights from São Paulo (GRU) and Belo Horizonte (CNF). There are other options for nearby airports such as Uberaba (UBA) 120 km away and Uberlância (UDI) 180 km away.
06.2. TRAVEL BY CAR For those coming by car, the journey from Mairiporã to Araxa is around 600 km. To travel along better roads, we suggest taking the route Mairiporã, Ribeirão Preto, Uberaba and Araxá. It is important to have cash to pay the tolls, as not all of them accept cards. Only athletes and teams can arrive at the event location by car. Cars must receive a sticker to be glued to the glass.
06.3. TRAVEL BY PUBLIC TRANSPORT Only athletes and teams can arrive by car at the Grande Hotel, the World Cup venue. We created a mobility project prioritizing the use of bicycles and public transport. We will have the Mountain Bike Village, which has parking and exclusive bus lines towards the World Cup venue. For those who go by bike, we will have free bike parking and space reservations can be made at <u>mtbwc.com.br</u> .
06.4. VISA INFORMATION As of April 10 th , all foreign nationals from these Nations will require an E- Visa to enter Brazil; AUSTRALIA, USA AND CANADA. Please ensure enough time is given to apply for visa's which can be applied for <u>HERE</u> . The cost of the E-Visa is US\$80.90. If you travel to Brazil <u>before April 10th</u> , an E-Visa is not required.
06.5. ACCOMODATION For accommodation in Araxá we have hotels blocked to serve athletes and teams until December 15th, 2023. After that, it is possible to choose houses and farms from the list that will be on <u>mtbwc.com.br</u>
06.6. CAMPINGAt Mountain Bike Village we will have camping and motorhome parking with a restaurant, bathrooms and showers. The MTB Village is about 5 km away from the world cup venue with a signposted cycle path.Reservations for camping and motorhome space must be made by email at reservas@bicimobiexperience.com 0r via Whatsapp +55 34 99952- 1713

	06.7. PARKING FOR ATHLETES Athletes and teams will be the only ones who will have access to the World Cup venue by car. There we will have an exclusive parking lot with a concierge with entry control and all cars must have stickers glued to the windshield.
	06.8. PARKING FOR SPECTATORS Only athletes and teams can arrive by car at the Grande Hotel, the World Cup venue. We created a mobility project prioritizing the use of bicycles and public transport. We will have the Mountain Bike Village, which has parking and exclusive bus lines towards the World Cup venue. For those who go by bike, we will have free bike parking and space reservations can be made at <u>mtbwc.com.br</u>
	06.9. TOILETS The event will have several VIP bathrooms spread throughout the fair. In the athletes' restricted areas (Grande Hotel Club and underground of the Grande Hotel) there are exclusive bathrooms for athletes and teams.
	06.10. SHOWERS Grande Hotel Club has changing rooms with showers exclusively for athletes and teams.
	06.11. WASTE MANAGEMENT We will manage recyclable and non-recyclable waste within the event together with the work of the Grande Hotel. This work is carried out in partnership with Araxá City Hall.
(76	06.12. WI-FI AND NETWORK In the team areas (Grande Hotel Club and underground Grande Hotel) we will have a central point with internet available.
₽	06.13. SECURITY Exclusive security hire is available upon request only with paddock booking within the relevant timeframe. Please do not leave bikes or equipment unattended at any time. Although surveillance will be in place individuals are responsible for their personal property at all times.
	06.14. BIKE WASH The organization will have a free bike wash available near the Grande Hotel Club.

	 07.2. NEAREST HOSPITAL/ PHARMACY The closest Hospital to the event venue can be found as per the below. UPA - Emergency Care Unit - <u>Av. João Paulo II, 1900 - Centro, Araxá</u> – MG. 6 km away Grande Hotel Araxa (World Cup Venue). The closest Pharmacy to the event venue can be found as per the below. Araxá has many pharmacy options spread across the city. On Imbiara avenue (5 km away World Cup Venue) there are at least 10 different pharmacies
	07.3. PHYSIO One of the partners of the Araxá World Cup, and the Physiotherapy course at UNIARAXÁ (University of Araxá), which sets up a space at the event fair for free consultations for athletes with interns from the physiotherapy course.
07.4. MEDICAL	AND CONCUSSION PROTOCOL

WBD & the UCI are committed to improving rider safety & ensuring that athletes taking part in our events receive the highest standard of medical care possible. One area where we want to ensure consistency across all MTB disciplines at our events is the identification of potential rider head injury / concussion events & the subsequent assessment & medical diagnosis of concussions where necessary. *Continued...*





MEDICAL

The UCI have a <u>concussion protocol</u> & we will, in conjunction with the LOC appointed medical team, be applying this protocol across all disciplines during training & races. Any rider who has an incident which could result in a head injury / concussion & is then asked to undergo a concussion assessment by a member of the event medic team must comply with this request. Likewise, any rider or team manager who suspects a concussion should refer themselves or their athlete to the event medical team as soon as possible. A positive diagnosis of concussion by a medical professional may result in that athlete being withdrawn from competition.
