RACE ENTRIES 02.1 <u>RIDER REGISTRATION</u>

All registrations for Enduro and E-Enduro UCI World Cup and Open Racing categories will be through the <u>www.ucimtbworldseries.com</u> website.

UCI Enduro World Cup

In order to race in the UCI Enduro World Cup, riders must either be on an official UCI Enduro or Mixed Team or have the minimum required number of Global Ranking points or direct upgrades. **Minimum Points:**

- Men Elite: 125 points
- Women Elite: 125 points
- Men U21: 75 points
- Women U21: 50 points

Open Racing

There is no pre-qualification requirements, however please refer to the Race License section for specific requirements as per the Italian Federation.

Entries are offered on a first come first served basis.

For information on how to qualify into the UCI Enduro World Cup, please refer to Chapter 2 of the 2024 Enduro Rulebook.

02.2 RACE LICENCES

UCI World Cup

All riders must hold a valid (in date) UCI licence issued by their National Federation. Riders will be required to present their licenses at rider confirmation.

Open Racing

Active / valid UCI ID licences are required for riders to be eligible to collect UCI Enduro World Cup qualifying points. Your UCI Number must be added to your rider account.

International riders

Foreign riders can race the Open race with an international annual license issued by their own national cycling federation.

Riders will be required to present their license (copies or photos acceptable) at the onsite checkin.

Unlicensed foreign racers will also have the option to purchase a one event license from the Italian Cycling Federation at the onsite check-in (see Day License section below for requirements).

Italian riders

Italian racers will have the option to race with either an annual UCI/FCI license or a license from an Enti della Consulta organization.

Day Licensing Requirements

Questions regarding the FCI Fattore k IDs and registration requirements should be directed to the Federation <u>https://www.federciclismo.it/it/</u>

Day Licenses are not available for junior (year of birth 2006-2007) racers. All junior racers must have a race license issued by their own national cycling federation.

Racers must have a <u>DataHealth verified</u> certificate of fitness for competitive cycling issued within the previous 12 months. Certificates for other types of sport such as triathlon, duathlon, athletics, etc. are not valid). At on site check in, athletes must show proof of the DataHealth verified medical certificate in one of the following ways.

- FCI registered athletes: License with DataHealth logo as well as the expiry date of the certificate of fitness for competitive cycling.
- non-FCI registered athletes: DataHealth QRcode-DH (with data consistent with the type and date of the event). <u>Instructions</u> to use DataHealth service to obtain QRcode-DH.

Please note: The DataHealth validation process can take up 3-4 days - please allow sufficient time in advance of the race to obtain the QRcode-DH.

Day licenses will be purchasable on location during registration. A day license will be needed for each day of the competition, including training. The cost is 10€ per day license purchased.

FCI AMOTORI JUNIOR SPORT

Italian riders with a FCI Amatori Junior Sport (JMT or JWS) license are not eligible to race in the Open E-EDR nor EDR. Any Italian racer within this category will need to have a race license for professional sport (FCI JUNIORES license category)

02.6 INSURANCE

Personal insurance coverage is not provided by the WBDS/Organisers. Racers are responsible for securing their own accident, rescue, health, travel, property and liability insurance.

Racers should have the following insurance coverage:

- Bodily injury (in and out-patient hospital expenses and medical care, emergency rescue and medical transport costs, permanent disablement, death) and material damages (loss of earnings) in case of accident in the course of the Event or during training
- Third-party liability insurance for material damage or bodily injury caused to others in the course of the Event or during training.

02.7 DISCLAIMER AND LIABILITY RELEASE

Racers voluntarily assume full and complete responsibility for all risks associated with participating in the Event and for any injury, accident or damage that may occur during their participation in the Event, including by way of example and not limitation: (a) travelling to and from the Event; (b) falls; (c) mechanical failures of equipment; (d) collisions with other participants, spectators and fixed or moving objects; (e) the effects of weather, including temperature extremes; (f) use of chairlifts, gondola or shuttle vehicles; (g) traffic accidents; (h) trail and road conditions; and (i) the negligence of themselves and/or others.

02.8 CANCELLATION POLICY

Organisers reserve the right to modify the schedule, format, duration, course, individual race stages or any other aspect of the Event, or delay or cancel the Event (or any individual race stages), if they believe the conditions are unsafe or otherwise unsuitable for the Event. If an Event is relocated and/or rescheduled, the entries will be automatically transferred to the new date and/or location.

If a Racer is unable to attend the scheduled/ rescheduled dates and/or venue, the **entry fees are refundable up to 30 days before** (less €30 processing fee). See section 2.4. WITHDRAWAL within <u>Event Entry T&C's.</u>

04.3 TRAINING

Official training will take place on **Friday 10th May** for both EDR and E-EDR.

All riders and team staff must display their handlebar number during training sessions. As per the 2024 Enduro Rulebook (Article 1.1.5), **only** Official UCI Enduro Teams will be provided team plates to allow team staff on course during practice only.

Race stages are closed during official training to all racers but media and official UCI Enduro World Cup Team staff.

Any rider training without a plate or outside the official schedule will be disqualified.

Shuttling will be permitted during training day only on specific liaisons (to be communicated on course-release day)

Racers can either use personal / private shuttles or the commercial / public shuttle service offered by Finale Outdoor Region (see below)

04.4 SHUTTLES

Practice uplift **will not be included** in the Entry Fee.

COMMERCIAL PUBLIC SHUTTLE BOOKING

Finale Outdoor Region is the only authorized public commercial shuttle service for the UCI Enduro World Cup and Open Enduro of Finale Outdoor Region. *Limited capacity, must be pre booked on the following link:*<u>HERE</u> Training shuttle booking will close at 12:00 (noon) on Thursday the 9th of May.

IMPORTANT SHUTTLE INFORMATION FOR PRACTICE DAY

Shuttling will be permitted during training day only on paved roads and specific liaisons. See below:

All riders:

vehicle access to the Nato Base area (where Stage Base Nato and Ingegnere start) is partially
restricted to only-authorised vehicles (including public shuttle service provided by Finale
Outdoor Region, see above). Drop off point at the link <u>here</u> and outlined in the map below. From
the drop-off point, the start of stage will be reachable only on foot or by riding.







EDR riders (both UCI World Cup and Open Racing):

04.5 TIMING CHIP COLLECTION

Timing system: Chrono Race All riders are responsible for the return of their transponder in the finish area. Any non-returned transponder will be invoiced 100 euros.

04.9 PROTECTION RULES

Protection rules will follow the rules stipulated by the Italian Cycling Federation and the 2024 Enduro Rulebook.

Mandatory protections (to be worn during official practice and race on stages):

- full face helmet with visor and no detachable chin guard
- back protection
- full-finger gloves
- knee pads

It is strongly recommended the use of: - elbow pads

Full face helmets and knee pads mandatory during the special stages. Open face helmets can be worn during liaison stages/transitions.

Podium presentations will be made for the top 3 riders in each category as soon as possible after the last finishing rider.

All riders must attend the podium as scheduled as stipulated in the 2024 Enduro Rulebook. Leader's jerseys will be awarded to the series leader in UCI Enduro and E-Enduro World Cup categories.

Open Racing

The top 3 from each race category will be awarded as soon as possible after the last finishing rider.

04.12 PRIZE MONEY COLLECTION

Prize money will be paid by the local organising team. Please follow the below process to claim your prize money if you place Top 10 in Elite Men OR Women in EDR and E-EDR.

Due to the set-up plans of the paddocks, all UCI Teams cannot arrive until **Wednesday 8th May** 13:00 to set-up.

07.5. MEDICAL AND CONCUSSION PROTOCOL

WBD & the UCI are committed to improving rider safety & ensuring that athletes taking part in our events receive the highest standard of medical care possible. One area where we want to ensure consistency across all MTB disciplines at our events is the identification of potential rider head injury / concussion events & the subsequent assessment & medical diagnosis of concussions where necessary.

The UCI have a <u>concussion protocol</u> & we will, in conjunction with the LOC appointed medical team, be applying this protocol across all disciplines during training & races. Any rider who has an incident which could result in a head injury / concussion & is then asked to undergo a concussion assessment by a member of the event medic team must comply with this request. Likewise, any rider or team manager who suspects a concussion should refer themselves or their athlete to the event medical team as soon as possible. A positive diagnosis of concussion by a medical professional may result in that athlete being withdrawn from competition.
