RACE ENTRIES

02.1 RIDER REGISTRATION

All registrations for Enduro and E-Enduro UCI World Cup and Open Racing categories will be through the <u>www.ucimtbworldseries.com</u> website.

Further details will be confirmed in the upcoming months on the process to make entries.

UCI Enduro World Cup

In order to race in the UCI Enduro World Cup, riders must either be on an official UCI Enduro or Mixed Team or have the minimum required number of Global Ranking points or direct upgrades. **Minimum Points:**

- Men Elite: 125 points
- Women Elite: 125 points
- Men U21: 75 points
- Women U21: 50 points

Open Racing

There is no pre-qualification requirements, however please refer to the Race License section for specific requirements as per the Swiss Federation.

Entries are offered on a first come first served basis.

There will also be a Youth Category as part of this race. The minimum age is 15.

For information on how to qualify into the UCI Enduro World Cup, please refer to Chapter 2 of the <u>2024 Enduro</u> <u>Rulebook.</u>

02.2 RACE LICENCES

UCI World Cup

All riders must hold a valid (in date) UCI licence issued by their National Federation. Riders will be required to present their licenses at rider confirmation.

Open Racing

Active / valid UCI ID licences are required for riders to be eligible to collect UCI Enduro World Cup qualifying points. Your UCI Number must be added to your rider account.

02.6 INSURANCE

Personal insurance coverage is not provided by the WBDS/Organisers. Racers are responsible for securing their own accident, rescue, health, travel, property and liability insurance. Racers should have the following insurance coverage:

- Bodily injury (in and out-patient hospital expenses and medical care, emergency rescue and medical transport costs, permanent disablement, death) and material damages (loss of earnings) in case of accident in the course of the Event or during training
- Third-party liability insurance for material damage or bodily injury caused to others in the course of the Event or during training.
- Expenses tied to the mountain rescue including helicopter rescue and ambulances

MOUNTAIN RESCUE INSURANCE

Helicopters are routinely utilised in Aletsch to evacuate injured individuals from the mountain - even for relatively minor injuries. Racers should accordingly verify that their insurance policies cover helicopter evacuations, in particular for competitions.

02.7 DISCLAIMER AND LIABILITY RELEASE

Racers voluntarily assume full and complete responsibility for all risks associated with participating in the Event and for any injury, accident or damage that may occur during their participation in the Event, including by way of example and not limitation: (a) travelling to and from the Event; (b) falls; (c) mechanical failures of equipment; (d) collisions with other participants, spectators and fixed or moving objects; (e) the effects of weather, including temperature extremes; (f) use of chairlifts, gondola or shuttle vehicles; (g) traffic accidents; (h) trail and road conditions; and (i) the negligence of themselves and/or others.

02.8 CANCELLATION POLICY

Organisers reserve the right to modify the schedule, format, duration, course, individual race stages or any other aspect of the Event, or delay or cancel the Event (or any individual race stages), if they believe the conditions are unsafe or otherwise unsuitable for the Event.

If an Event is relocated and/or rescheduled, the entries will be automatically transferred to the new date and/or location.

If a Racer is unable to attend the scheduled/rescheduled dates and/or venue, the **entry fees are refundable up to 30 days before** (less €30 processing fee). See section 2.4. WITHDRAWAL within <u>Event Entry T&C's.</u>

The event hub with start and finish bowl, team paddocks, expo and fan zone is located in the heart of the village Fiesch.

The 2 Destinations:

The Aletsch Arena and Bellwald are located in the eastern part of the canton of Valais in Switzerland. This region lies to the south of the Aletsch Glacier, the largest glacier in the Alps.

With its 100km of pistes, Aletsch Arena is an enduro paradise. Marked by an impressive panorama and the majestic Aletsch Glacier, the region offers unique experiences. 04.3 TRAINING

TRAINING SCHEDULE

Thursday 11th July 09:00 – 17:00 : Practice – All Riders

Official training will take place on **Thursday 11th July** for both Enduro and E-Enduro

All riders and team staff must display their handlebar number during training sessions. As per the <u>2024 Enduro</u> <u>Rulebook</u> (Article 1.1.5), only Official UCI Enduro Teams will be provided team plates to allow team staff on course during practice only.

Race stages are closed during official training to all racers but media and official UCI Enduro World Cup Team staff. Any rider training without a plate or outside the official schedule will be disqualified.

04.4 SHUTTLES

Transportation is by cable car. The cable car tickets for practice day and race day is included in the fee.

As a racer, you don't need a cable car ticket. Racers have a priority line at the stations and are allowed through with their start numbers. Please note: Only racers with a valid start number blade on their bike can pass through. This is only valid during practice and races.

TEAM PADDOCK PROCEDURES

05.1. TEAM AREA ACCESS

For every team, paddock and sponsor, a designated area will be prepared in advance. The <u>CHECKPOINT</u> will be at the "FIESCHERTALSTRASSE 28 PARKING". You must pass through this checkpoint to be assigned your space.

• To use the Swiss highways, it is necessary to purchase a highway vignette. It can be purchased either online (evignette) or directly at a service station.

A FEW REMINDERS, TO PLEASE DO NOT DO THE FOLLOWING;

- Make any holes in the tarmac or any other surface.
- Put any products or soaps in the water points.
- Drive on Sunday or during the night with your truck, it's not allowed in Switzerland.

05.2. ADDITIONAL TEAM PARKING

There will be space for only one team vehicle per team which is not included in team paddock set-ups next to the team paddock area.

05.3. TEAM DE-RIG AND DEPARTURES

No teams are permitted to begin de-rig of their paddocks before **16:00 Sunday 14th July,** any team who begins de-rig before this time will be charged the €1,000 early departure fee.

	06.3 TRAVEL BY PUBLIC TRANSPORT
	The Swiss public transport network is very well developed and trains run regularly and punctually.
•	General arrival to the tourist destination Aletsch Arena and Bellwald: The mountain villages of Riederalp, Bettmeralp and Fiescheralp on the sunny Aletsch Arena plateau are car-free and very well served by public transport. The Mörel- Riederalp, Betten Talstation-Bettmeralp and Fiesch-Fiescheralp trains run all year round and are part of the SBB network. In Brig, a change to the Matterhorn Gotthard Bahn takes passengers to the Fürgangen-Bellwald stop. From there, Bellwald station can be reached by the Fürgangen cable car (bikes are accepted on the cable car).
	Enjoy comfortable and climate-friendly travel to the Aletsch Arena by public transport and have your luggage transported separately. The SBB offers you <u>various options for</u> <u>transporting luggage, skis</u> and even <u>mountain bikes</u> .

07.5. MEDICAL AND CONCUSSION PROTOCOL

WBD & the UCI are committed to improving rider safety & ensuring that athletes taking part in our events receive the highest standard of medical care possible. One area where we want to ensure consistency across all MTB disciplines at our events is the identification of potential rider head injury / concussion events & the subsequent assessment & medical diagnosis of concussions where necessary.

The UCI have a <u>concussion protocol</u> & we will, in conjunction with the LOC appointed medical team, be applying this protocol across all disciplines during training & races.

Any rider who has an incident which could result in a head injury / concussion & is then asked to undergo a concussion assessment by a member of the event medic team must comply with this request. Likewise, any rider or team manager who suspects a concussion should refer themselves or their athlete to the event medical team as soon as possible. A positive diagnosis of concussion by a medical professional may result in that athlete being withdrawn from competition.
