03.1 RIDER REGISTRATION

- All registrations for Cross-country Olympic and Cross-country Short Track World Cup categories will need to be made on the www.ucimtbworldseries.com website by all WHOOP UCI MTB World Series Teams, UCI teams and National Federation teams.
- All privateer riders must register their entry with their National Federation first before proceeding with payment.

03.2 RACE LICENSES

All riders must hold a valid (in date) UCI licence issued by their National Federation.

03.3 ENTRY FEES

UCI Cross-Country World Cup: € 150.00

All entry fees must be paid online at www.ucimtbworldseries.com before rider confirmation. No race numbers can be collected without payment. No cash or card payment will be available at event.

03.4 RIDER CONFIRMATION & NUMBER COLLECTION

LOCATION – The rider confirmation entrance is located between the entrance to Paddock A (underground UCI World Series Team Area) and the anti-doping testing room. This area is behind the music stage and near the bike wash area - see the Site Plan on Page 13/14 for the location.

03.5 TEAM AND RIDER EVENT ACCREDITATION

- Season and event passes will be distributed in Araxá at the Rider Confirmation location. However, in addition ALL riders and members of staff will be issued a wristband which **must be worn** to enter the event arena and team areas, at all times
- Team plates will be allocated as follows:
 - UCI World Series Teams: 2 plates
 - UCI MTB Team Wildcards : 1 plate
 - National Federations: 1 plate

03.6 INSURANCE

- Personal insurance coverage is not provided by the WBDS/Organisers
Racers are responsible for securing their own accident, rescue, health, travel, property and liability insurance
- Racers should have the following insurance coverage, that also covers competition:
 - Bodily injury (in and out-patient hospital expenses and medical care, emergency rescue and medical transport costs, permanent disablement, death) and material damages (loss of earnings) in case of accident on the course of the Event or during training
 - Third-party liability insurance for material damage or bodily injury caused to others on the course of the Event or during training

03.7 DISCLAIMER AND LIABILITY RELEASE

Racers voluntarily assume full and complete responsibility for all risks associated with participating in the Event and for any injury, accident or damage that may occur during their participation in the Event, including by way of example and not limitation: (a) travelling to and from the Event; (b) falls; (c) mechanical failures of equipment; (d) collisions with other participants, spectators and fixed or moving objects; (e) the effects of weather, including temperature extremes; (f) use of chairlifts, gondola or shuttle vehicles; (g) traffic accidents; (h) trail and road conditions; and (i) the negligence of themselves and/or others.

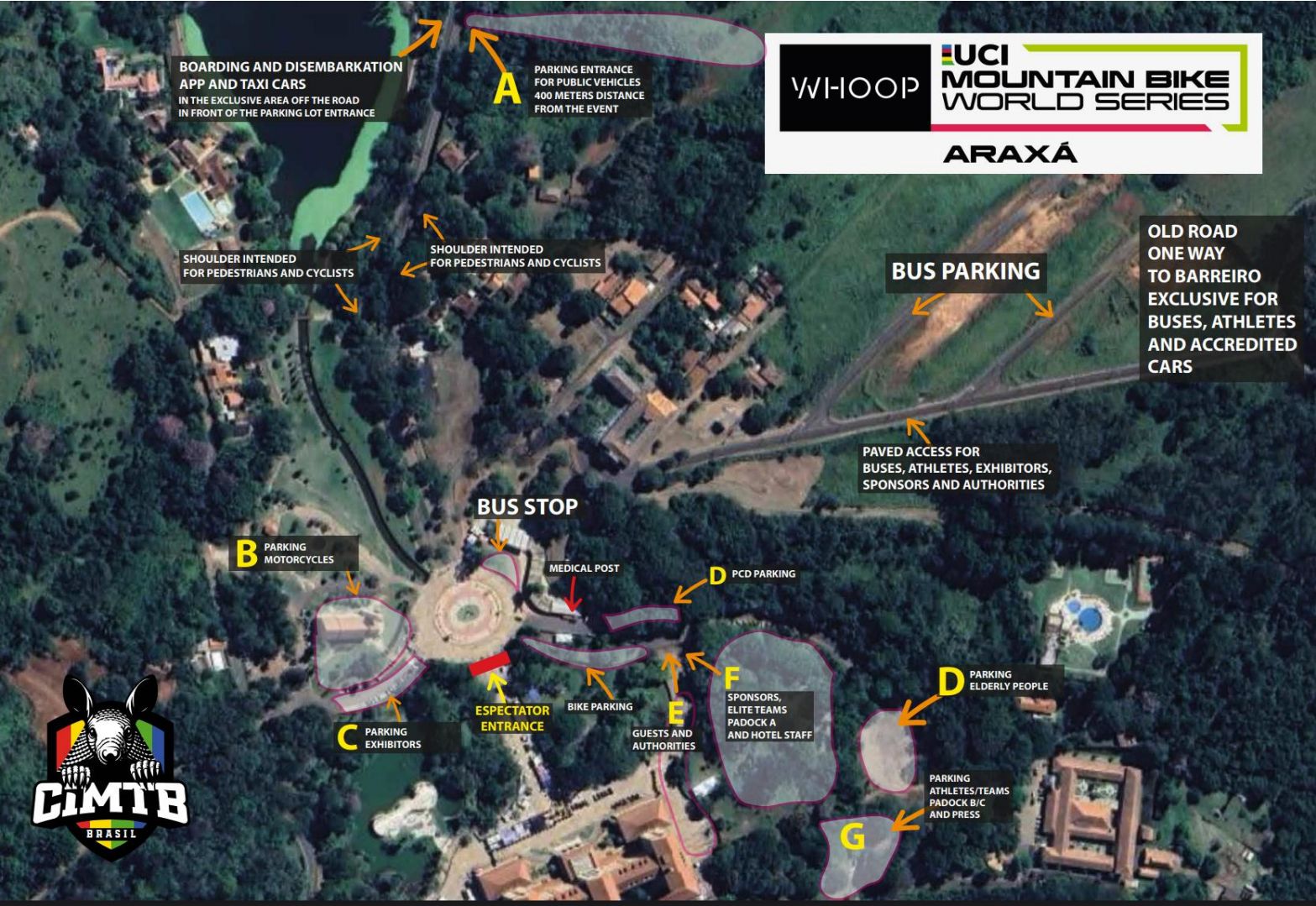

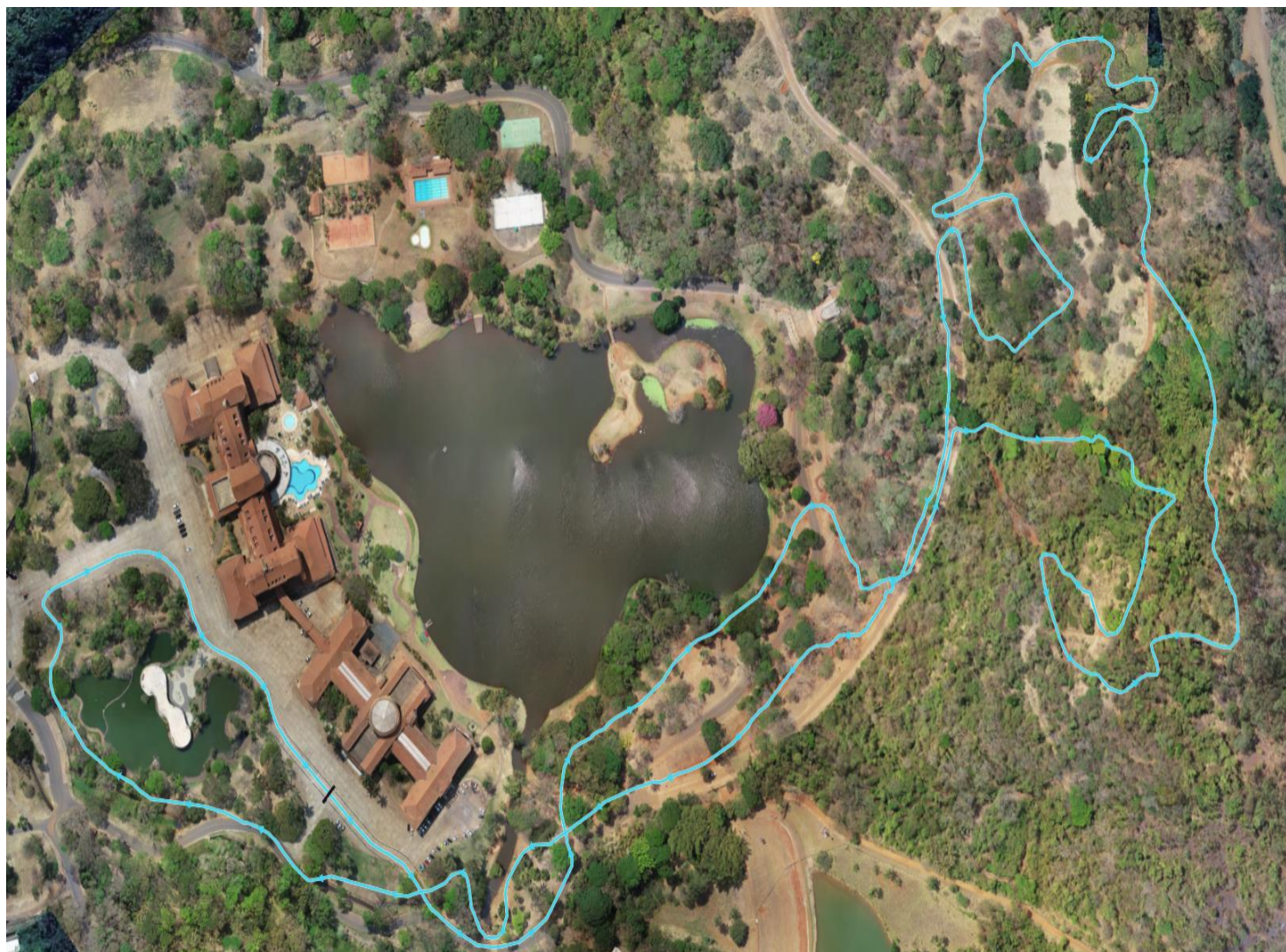
VENUE PARKING MAP

04.7 TIMING TRANSPONDER COLLECTION

- Timing system: [Chronorace](#)
- Racers must secure their Timing Transponders on their bike fork
- Timing Transponders can be collected between 30 - 90 minutes before the start of each race (see LOCATION below prize money collection)
- All riders are responsible for the return of their transponder in the finish area
- Any non-returned transponder will be invoiced 100 euros

- All prize money will be paid in CASH in Brazilian Real on the day; it is not possible for prize money to be sent via BACS transfer after the event.

05 TEAMS

05.1 TEAM PADDOCK ACCESS

There will be two team areas, one in the Grande Hotel Club (Paddock B/C) and the other in the underground team area (Paddock A), with access control with different colored wristbands for each area.

All athletes and team members must have wristbands to enter Paddock A and Paddock B/C. Anyone without an identification wristband will not be allowed to enter. We ask that everyone respect this rule so that we have full control of the area, ensuring safety and quality in the spaces.

There will be an exclusive access route to the start, through the underground team area for all athletes, including athletes in Paddock B/C. Athletes in Paddock B/C must have the Paddock A wristband to use this access. Otherwise, they must use the external access to reach the start.

Athletes and teams going to the event venue by car should follow the signs that will indicate GRANDE HOTEL - LOCAL DA COPA DO MUNDO.

To get to GRANDE HOTEL we suggest taking the ESTRADA VELHA BARREIRO (old Barreiro road) route, which will be exclusive to accredited vehicles. The main road will be used by spectators and may be very busy on race days.

Please refer to the venue access maps for info on routes into the venue.

All teams must arrive by Wednesday, 2nd April at 9pm local time, any late arrivals will incur a €1,000 fine.

Arriving at the Paddock: Please ensure that you adhere to the opening hours. Paddock A/B/C will be open from 7am to 9pm local time.

For athletes and team members arriving by bike, we will have a cycle path on the shoulder of the main road connecting the city to the World Cup venue.

05.2 ADDITIONAL TEAM AND ATHLETE PARKING

Athletes and teams will be the only ones who will have access to the World Cup venue by car.

We will have three exclusive parking lots with controlled entry and all cars must have parking sticker showing on the windshield.

The number of parking spaces will be as follows:

- Paddock A: 1 car in the parking lot inside Paddock A and 2 cars in the parking lot next to Paddock A
- Paddock B/C: teams can have 2 cars and individual athletes can have 1 car
- Cars in the three types of parking above will only be allowed to enter with the sticker showing on the windshield of the car
- Cars without stickers will not be able to enter

The LOC will provide parking stickers upon arrival.

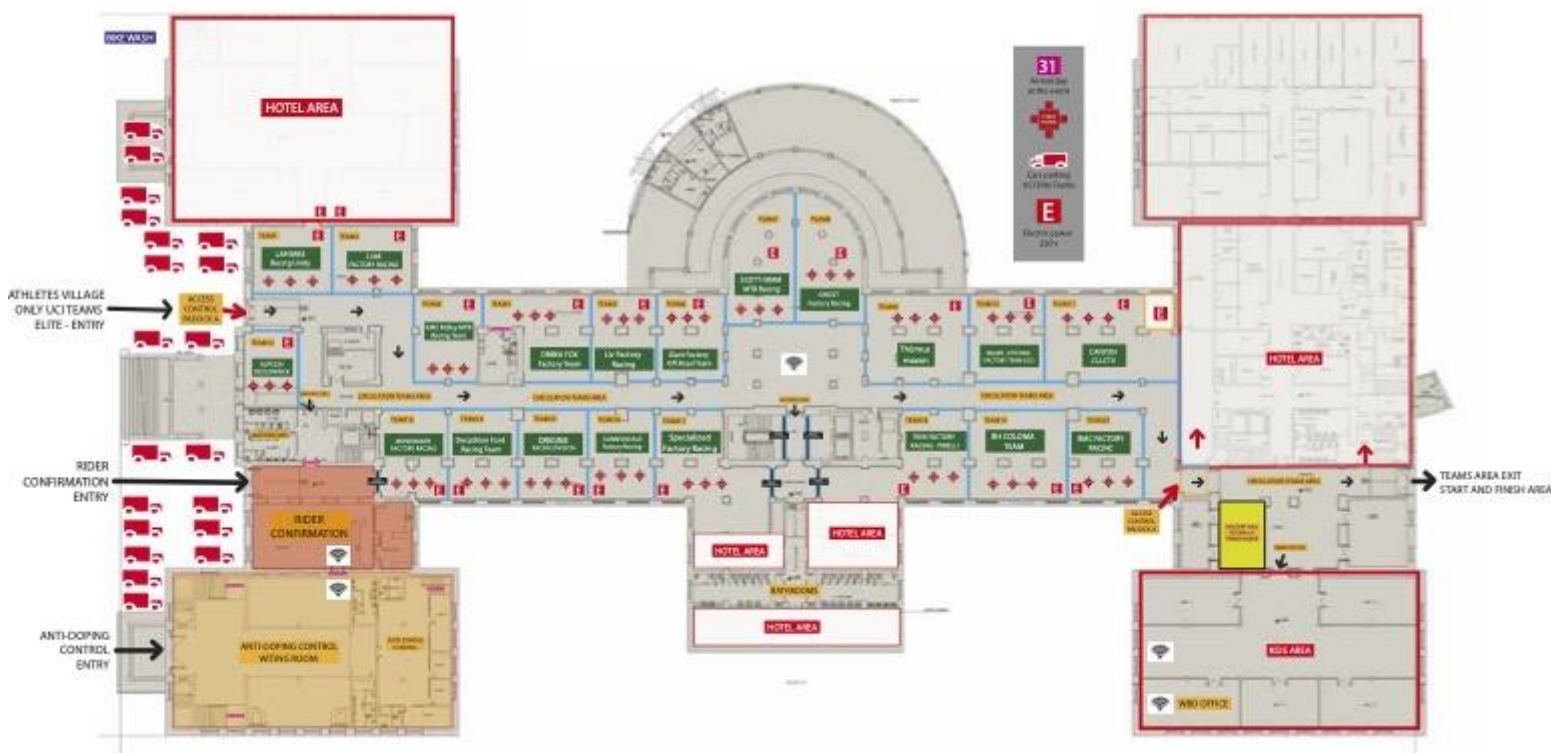
05.3 TEAM DE-RIG AND DEPARTURES

PADDOCK A - FACILITIES

Paddock A is dedicated to WHOOP UCI MTB World Series Teams and will be in the same location as last year, on the ground floor of the Grande Hotel Termas de Araxá.

Within Paddock A you will be provided with the following:

- 220v power for each team space - please bring your own adapters / converters and extra cables
- 3 tables and 12 chairs per team
- Access to a water fountain outside the Paddock A exit (next to trailer toilet) for all teams
- Security staff at entry / exit points
- Wifi is available in this area plus Air Conditioning
- Toilets – serviced every day / no showers
- Bike Wash is located just outside Paddock A, on the way to Paddock B/C
- Waste bins provided for each area
- Metal crowd barriers will divide each team area

Things to be aware of:

- Paddock A will open from 7am and closes at 10pm each day
- No bikes to be left overnight in Paddock A
- The LOC take no responsibility for anything left overnight, however a lockable container can be rented at an extra cost directly from them for Teams who require them
- A wristband will be required in addition to your Accreditation to access Paddock A - this will be distributed by our Team Liaison, Seb Ramsay
- Spectators are not allowed in Paddock A, at certain times VIP's and guests will have access to Paddock A, scheduled not to interfere with your race preparation
- **NO** hot works or cooking is permitted within the basement areas
- Athletes from Paddock B/C must wear a Paddock A wristband if they want to access the starting area through the Grand Hotel. Anyone not wearing a wristband will have to use the external access to the starting area.

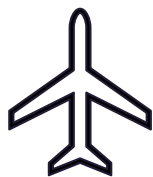

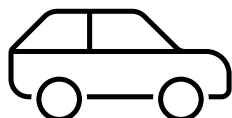

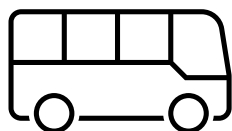
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**06.1 INTERNATIONAL AIRPORTS**

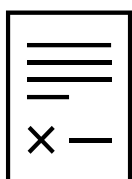
Araxá airport (code AAX) receives direct flights from São Paulo (GRU) and Belo Horizonte (CNF).
There are other options for nearby airports such as Uberaba (UBA) 120 km away and Uberlândia (UDI) 180 km away.

**06.2 TRAVEL BY CAR**

For those coming by car: To travel along better roads, we suggest taking the route Mairiporã, Ribeirão Preto, Uberaba and Araxá. It is important to have cash to pay the tolls, as not all of them accept cards. Only athletes and teams can arrive at the event location by car. Cars must receive a sticker to be glued to the glass.

**06.3 TRAVEL BY PUBLIC TRANSPORT**

Only athletes and teams can arrive by car at the Grande Hotel, the World Cup venue. We created a mobility project prioritizing the use of bicycles and public transport. We will have the Mountain Bike Village, which has parking and exclusive bus lanes towards the World Cup venue. For those who go by bike, we will have free bike parking and space reservations can be made at mtbwc.com.br.

**06.4 VISA INFORMATION**

As of April 10th, 2025 all foreign nationals from these Nations will require an E-Visa (electronic visa) to enter Brazil; **AUSTRALIA, USA AND CANADA**. Please ensure enough time is given to apply for visa's which can be applied.

The cost of the E-Visa is US\$80.90.

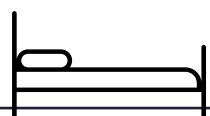
If you travel to Brazil before April 10th, 2025 an E-Visa is not required.

It is recommended that you apply for a visa in advance, as processing can take up to five business days.

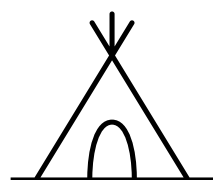

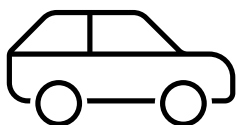

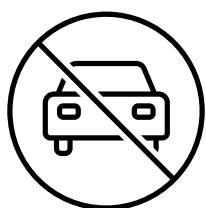
**06.6. CAMPING**

**06.7 PARKING FOR ATHLETES**

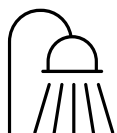

In the team areas (Grande Hotel Club and underground Grande Hotel) we will have a central point with internet available.

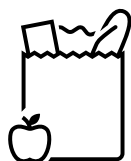
**06.13 SECURITY**

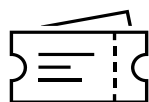

A medical team will be in attendance during all official practice and competition times.

The medical team will consist of doctors, paramedics and first responders. These resources will be located on courses as well as at the event medical centre located at the event entrance roundabout.

07.4 MEDICAL AND CONCUSSION PROTOCOL

WBD & the UCI are committed to improving rider safety & ensuring that athletes taking part in our events receive the highest standard of medical care possible. One area where we want to ensure consistency across all MTB disciplines at our events is the identification of potential rider head injury / concussion events & the subsequent assessment & medical diagnosis of concussions where necessary.

The UCI have a [concussion protocol](#) & we will, in conjunction with the LOC appointed medical team, be applying this protocol across all disciplines during training & races.

Any rider who has an incident which could result in a head injury / concussion & is then asked to undergo a concussion assessment by a member of the event medic team must comply with this request. Likewise, any rider or team manager who suspects a concussion should refer themselves or their athlete to the event medical team as soon as possible. A positive diagnosis of concussion by a medical professional may result in that athlete being withdrawn from competition.
