RACE ENTRIES

02.1 RIDER REGISTRATION

UCI Enduro World Cup

To qualify for the UCI Enduro World Cup, one of the following criteria must be met:

- Member of a UCI Mountain Bike World Series Team or UCI Mountain Bike Team.
- Current National, Continental or World Champion
- National Federation quota
- Minimum Global Ranking position

Riders who meet the Global Ranking criteria must apply for entry through their National Federation.

Open Racing

There is no pre-qualification requirements. Please refer to the Race Licence section for the specific requirements of the Italian Federation.

Entries are offered on a first come first served basis.

Register through the <u>www.ucimtbworldseries.com</u> website for all Open Racing categories.

For information on how to qualify for the UCI Enduro World Cup, please refer to Chapter 2 of the 2025 Enduro Rulebook.

02.2 RACE LICENCES

UCI World Cup

All riders must hold a valid (in date) UCI licence issued by their National Federation. Riders will be required to present their licence at rider confirmation.

Open Racing

A valid UCI licence is not required for a rider to be eligible to score Enduro Global Ranking points, however if the rider accrues sufficient points to qualify for the UCI Enduro World Cup, they must have a valid UCI licence issued by their national federation prior to World Cup entry.

Your UCI I.D. number must be added to your rider account.

International riders

Foreign riders can race the Open race with an international annual licence issued by their own national cycling federation.

Riders will be required to present their licence (copies or photos acceptable) at the onsite rider confirmation

Unlicenced foreign racers will also have the option to purchase a one event licence from the Italian Cycling Federation at the onsite rider confirmation (see Day Licence section below for requirements).

Italian riders

Italian racers will have the option to race with either an annual UCI/FCI licence or a licence from an Enti della Consulta organization.

Day Licence Requirements

Day Licences are not available for junior (year of birth 2007-2008) riders. All junior riders must have a racing licence issued by their own national cycling federation.

Riders must have a <u>DataHealth verified</u> certificate of fitness for competitive cycling issued within the previous 12 months. Certificates for other types of sport such as triathlon, duathlon, athletics, etc. are not valid). At on-site rider confirmation athletes must show proof of the DataHealth verified medical certificate in one of the following ways.

- FCI registered athletes: Licence with DataHealth logo as well as the expiry date of the certificate of fitness for competitive cycling.
- non-FCI registered athletes: DataHealth QRcode-DH (with data consistent with the type and date of the event). <u>Instructions</u> to use DataHealth service to obtain QRcode-DH.

Please note: The DataHealth validation process can take up 3-4 days - please allow sufficient time in advance of the race to obtain the QRcode-DH.

Day licences can be purchased at rider confirmation onsite. A day licence will be needed for each day of the competition, including training. The cost is 10€ per day.

FCI AMOTORI JUNIOR SPORT

Italian riders with a FCI Amatori Junior Sport (JMT or JWS) licence are not eligible to race in the Open E-EDR nor EDR. Any Italian racer within this category will need to have a race licence for professional sport (FCI JUNIORES licence category)

No payment option will be available on-site – all payment must be completed online.

No payment, no entry.

02.6 INSURANCE

Personal insurance coverage is not provided by WBDS or the LOC.

Racers are responsible for securing their own accident, rescue, health, travel, property and liability insurance.

Racers should have the following insurance coverage:

- Bodily injury (in and out-patient hospital expenses and medical care, emergency rescue and medical transport costs, permanent disablement, death) and material damages (loss of earnings) in case of accident in the course of the Event or during training
- Third-party liability insurance for material damage or bodily injury caused to others in the course of the Event or during training.

02.7 DISCLAIMER AND LIABILITY RELEASE

Racers voluntarily assume full and complete responsibility for all risks associated with participating in the Event and for any injury, accident or damage that may occur during their participation in the Event, including by way of example and not limitation: (a) travelling to and from the Event; (b) falls; (c) mechanical failures of equipment; (d) collisions with other participants, spectators and fixed or moving objects; (e) the effects of weather, including temperature extremes; (f) use of chairlifts, gondola or shuttle vehicles; (g) traffic accidents; (h) trail and road conditions; and (i) the negligence of themselves and/or others.

02.8 CANCELLATION POLICY

Organisers reserve the right to modify the schedule, format, duration, course, individual race stages or any other aspect of the Event, or delay or cancel the Event (or any individual race stages), if they believe the conditions are unsafe or otherwise unsuitable for the Event. If an Event is relocated and/or rescheduled, the entries will be automatically transferred to the new date and/or location.

Open Racing entry fees are non-refundable. See section 2.4. WITHDRAWAL within **Event Entry T&C's**.









04.1 WORLD CUP COURSE MAP - DAY 1








WORLD CUP COURSE MAP - DAY 2

04.3 TRAINING

Official training will take place on:

- Thursday 8th and Friday 9th May for EDR World Cup
- Friday 9. May for both EDR and E-EDR Open

All riders and team staff must display their handlebar number plate during training sessions. As per the <u>2025 Enduro Rulebook</u> (Article 1.1.5), **only** WHOOP UCI World Series Teams and UCI Mountain Bike Teams will be provided team plates to allow team staff on course during practice only.

Race stages are closed during official training to all racers but media and official UCI Enduro World Cup Team staff.

Any rider training without a plate or outside the official schedule will be disqualified.

Riders must follow the designated liaisons during training.

04.4 SHUTTLES

IMPORTANT SHUTTLE INFORMATION FOR PRACTICE DAYS

Both World Cup and Open riders:

Due to local traffic & access restrictions on some stretches of the liaisons strictly no private shuttling will be permitted on training days.

Shuttles for stage 1 will be provided by the Local organization and **must** be used (see below).

Marshalls will be in place to ensure this rule is followed. Non-compliance will result in penalties up to & including DQ.

World Cup Riders:

Practice uplift will be included in the Entry Fee.

Strictly no private shuttling will be permitted during training and race. No practice shuttle booking required.

Training shuttles provided will start at the following location:

Piazzale Flavio Geddo, Pietra Ligure (SV)

Shuttles will run from 7:30 to 9:15 and will operate on a first come first served queueing system

Open riders:

No shuttling will be permitted during training and race. Marshalls will be in place to ensure this rule is followed. Non-compliance will result in penalties up to & including DQ.





04.5 TIMING TRANSPONDER COLLECTION

Timing system: ChronoRace

Timing transponders will be issued at comfirmation.

All riders are responsible for the return of their transponder in the finish area adjacent to the main stage. Any non-returned transponder will be invoiced 100 euros.

04.6 TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE ZONE (TAZ)

UCI EDR World Cup

There will be no Technical Assistance Zone on either of the two days of racing.

TAZ will be accessible AFTER completion of the final stage on day one

Open Racing

Outside assistance is permitted.





04.7 FEED ZONES

2 feed zones will be provided by the LOC on the course alongside additional water stations.

ENDURO WORLD CUP DAY 1

04.8 EQUIPMENT AND BIKE MARKING RULES

UCI Enduro World Cup

For all rider equipment competition requirements, please refer to the <u>2025 Enduro Rulebook</u> Article 0.5.1 and 0.5.2 for equipment marking sticker information.

Open Enduro Racing

For all rider equipment competition requirements, please refer to Article 0.5.1 of the <u>2025 Enduro</u> Rulebook.

Open E-Enduro Racing

For all rider equipment competition requirements, please refer to Article 0.5.1 and 2.1.6 of the 2025 Enduro Rulebook.

04.9 PROTECTION RULES

All riders must follow the rules stipulated by the Italian Cycling Federation and the 2025 Enduro Rulebook.

Mandatory protections (to be worn during official practice and race):

- full face helmet with visor and no detachable chin guard
- back protection
- full-finger gloves
- knee pads

It is strongly recommended to use:

- elbow pads

Full face helmets and knee pads are mandatory during the special stages. Open face helmets can be worn during liaison stages/transitions.

04.11 AWARD CEREMONIES

UCI Enduro World Cup

Award Ceremonies will take place at <u>Piazza S. Nicolò da Bari, Pietra Ligure</u> Podium presentations will be made for the top 3 riders in each category as soon as possible after the last finishing rider.

All riders must attend the podium as stipulated in the $\underline{2025\ Enduro\ Rulebook}$. Leader's jerseys will be awarded to the series leader in UCI Enduro World Cup categories.

Open Racing

The top 3 from each race category will be awarded as soon as possible after the last finishing rider.

04.12 PRIZE MONEY COLLECTION

Prize money will be paid by the local organising team. Please follow the below process to claim your prize money if you place Top 10 in Elite Men or Women in EDR World Cup or Top 3 Men or Women in EDR Open and E-EDR Open

Each athlete claiming prize money will be **required to send** the following info:

- Name and Surname
- Result placing
- Bank info: IBAN and BIC/SWIFT

within 24 hours from the award ceremony. Failure to do so may result in no payment

Minimum prize money amounts can be found within Article 1.2.8 of the 2025 Enduro Rulebook.

By Italian law, all the amounts are to be considered gross. Each amount is subject to a 20% tax

Paddock setup is allowed on **Tuesday, May 6th**, and **Wednesday, May 7th**, from **8:00 AM to 7:00 PM**.

All WHOOP UCI MTB World Series Teams should book paddock space directly with WBD.

05.2. TEAM AREA RESERVATION

UCI Teams and Open Teams can reserve a paid space by filling out the form available at this <u>link</u> no later than April 21st, 2025.

Payment must be made before setup.

The rates for the spaces are as follows:

- €200,00 for up to 30 sqm
- €300,00 for 30 to 50 sqm
- €350,00 for 50 to 70 sqm

Please note that without payment, setting up in the paddock will not be allowed.

05.2. ADDITIONAL TEAM AND ATHLETE PARKING

Any vehicles not included in your paddock set-up will need to use public parking or remain at your accommodation. No overflow car-parking is available from the LOC.

05.3. TEAM DE-RIG AND DEPARTURES

Teams must not de-rig their Team Paddock until 16:00 Sunday 11th May, any early departures/ de-rig's will be charged a €1,000 penalty fine.

All paddocks must be cleared by Monday 12th May at 12:00PM.

07.5. MEDICAL AND CONCUSSION PROTOCOL

WBD & the UCI are committed to improving rider safety & ensuring that athletes taking part in our events receive the highest standard of medical care possible. One area where we want to ensure consistency across all MTB disciplines at our events is the identification of potential rider head injury / concussion events & the subsequent assessment & medical diagnosis of concussions where necessary.

The UCI have a <u>concussion protocol</u> & we will, in conjunction with the LOC appointed medical team, be applying this protocol across all disciplines during training & races. Any rider who has an incident which could result in a head injury / concussion & is then asked to undergo a concussion assessment by a member of the event medic team must comply with this request. Likewise, any rider or team manager who suspects a concussion should refer themselves or their athlete to the event medical team as soon as possible. A positive diagnosis of concussion by a medical professional may result in that athlete being withdrawn from competition.
