04.1 RIDER REGISTRATION

All registrations for the UCI Enduro World Cup and Enduro & E-Enduro Open Racing categories must be made on the www.ucimtbworldseries.com website.

To qualify for the UCI Enduro World Cup one of the following criteria must be fulfilled:

- Member of an official UCI World Series Team or UCI Mountain Bike Team
- Current Champion
- National Federation Quota
- Minimum Global ranking position
- Men Top 300
- Women Top 75

Open Racing

There is no pre-qualification requirements, however, please refer to the Race Licence section for the specific requirements of the FFC.

Entries are offered on a first come first served basis.

04.2 RACE LICENCES

UCI World Cup

All riders must hold a valid (in date) UCI licence issued by their National Federation. Riders are required to present their licences at rider confirmation.

Open Racing

Licences are not mandatory however any rider who scores global ranking points & moves into a qualifying position **MUST then** have a valid licence before they can enter a World Cup race

Open Racing riders without a valid UCI licence must purchase Race Insurance from LOC, at a cost of €30, and present a medical certificate (no older than 6 months) stating that you are not contraindicated in the practice of Enduro mountain biking in competition.

Riders under 18 years of age must provide a notice of parental consent.

International riders must have UCI licence issued by their own national cycling federations or purchase race insurance from the LOC at a cost of ≤ 30

TRAINING SCHEDULE

Thursday 29th May 09:00 – 17:00 : Training – All Riders EDR World Cup 09:00 – 17:00 : Training – All Open Riders

Official training will take place on **Thursday 29th May** for both World Cup and Open Racing– full practice schedule will be released during the event week.

All riders and team staff must display their handlebar number during training sessions. As per the <u>2025 Enduro Rulebook</u> (Article 1.1.5), only Official UCI Enduro Teams will be provided team plates to allow team staff on course during practice only.

Race stages are closed during official training to all riders with the exception of media and official Whoop UCI Enduro World Cup Team staff.

Any rider training without a plate or outside the official schedule will be disqualified.

04.11 SHUTTLES AND LIFTS

All riders will have lift access for both practice and race.

04.12 TIMING TRANSPONDER COLLECTION

Timing system: Chronorace

Timing transponders will be distributed at rider confirmation.

All riders are responsible for the return of their transponder in the finish area at the end of the race. Any non-returned transponder will incur a charge of 100 euros.

04.13 TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE ZONE (TAZ)

TEAM AREA ACCESS

Paddock set up from Monday 26th to Wednesday 28th of May between 08:00 & 18:00. Set up schedule will be confirmed one week before the event. Contact Tom Waligorski - <u>waligorskitom@gmail.com</u> (+33 7 84 11 25 68) before arrival.

Please note: the ground is a mixture of grass and tarmac, and is flat.

There are no toilets at Paddock A

Power / water connection : connection schedule to be provided 1 week before the event. Travel restrictions will be in place for large trucks during the weekend.

When arriving at site – wait at: https://w3w.co/fameux.épaissir.constituer and call Tom Waligorski. Tom will advise you where to park and provide required services

TEAM PARKING

One team parking for DHI. One team parking for EDR. (see venue map, follow the signs).

DO NOT: Wash bikes in the paddock, use the bike washes provided, drill holes into the tarmac or other surfaces, use chemicals in the <u>water points</u>.

From Thursday 29th May to Sunday 1st June paddocks are accessible by car only between 5pm and 9am. All vehicles must be parked within the booked team space.

Any early de-rig or departures will incur the €1,000 penalty fine applied to your invoice post event. All invoicing will be issued post event.



07.4 MEDICAL AND CONCUSSION PROTOCOL

WBD & the UCI are committed to improving rider safety & ensuring that athletes taking part in our events receive the highest standard of medical care possible. One area where we want to ensure consistency across all MTB disciplines at our events is the identification of potential rider head injury / concussion events & the subsequent assessment & medical diagnosis of concussions where necessary

It is the responsibility of all team staff and riders to familiarise themselves with the signs and symptoms of a potential concussion. If they or their athlete display any symptoms, they are to present themselves to the on - site WBD medical liaison officer for assessment.

Any racer who is asked by a race official to undergo a medical or concussion assessment by a Registered / Licensed Health Care Professional must comply.

Any racer who fails or refuses a concussion assessment by a Registered / Licensed Health Care Professional during an event will be removed from the current training session or race. They will be prohibited from further participation until cleared in writing by a Registered / Licensed Health Care Professional to resume such activity.

Should a concussion be confirmed by a Registered / Licensed Health Care Professional, the athlete is responsible for completing a "graduated return to activity' plan.

During all WBD events, medical staff may collect preliminary racer injury and illness data, to monitor the magnitude of issues that occur. As part of a racer's participation, this will include a racer's medical data should any racer sustain an injury (or illness) during an event.

No racer will be identifiable at any stage during any collection of this data, and any data collected on a racer will be always anonymized and kept strictly confidential.

The information gathered may be used by WBD to help guide and direct future racer health and injury/illness prevention initiatives. A racer does not need to do anything as part of this data collection
