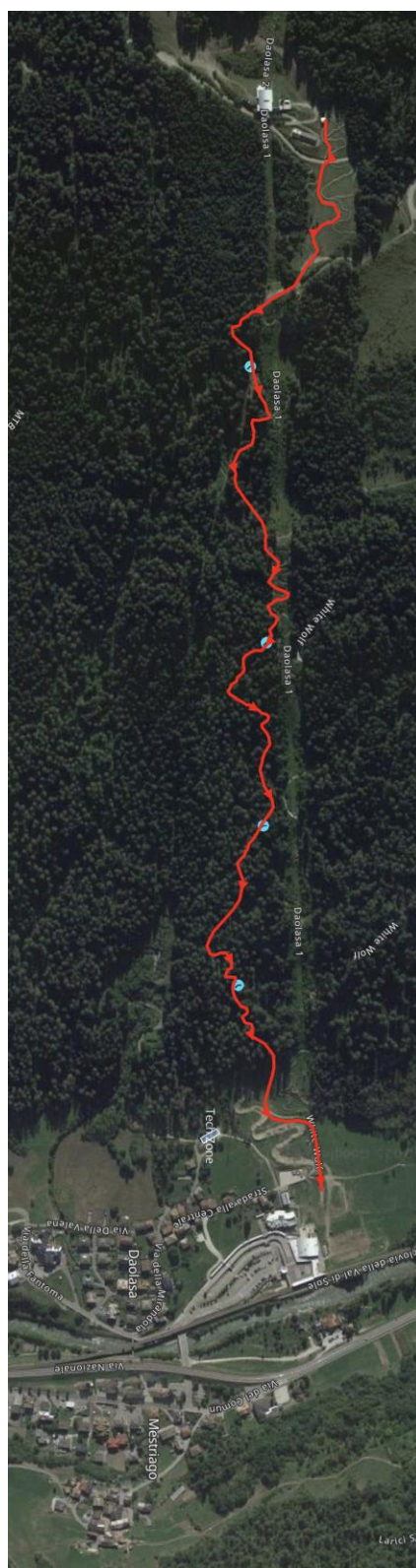

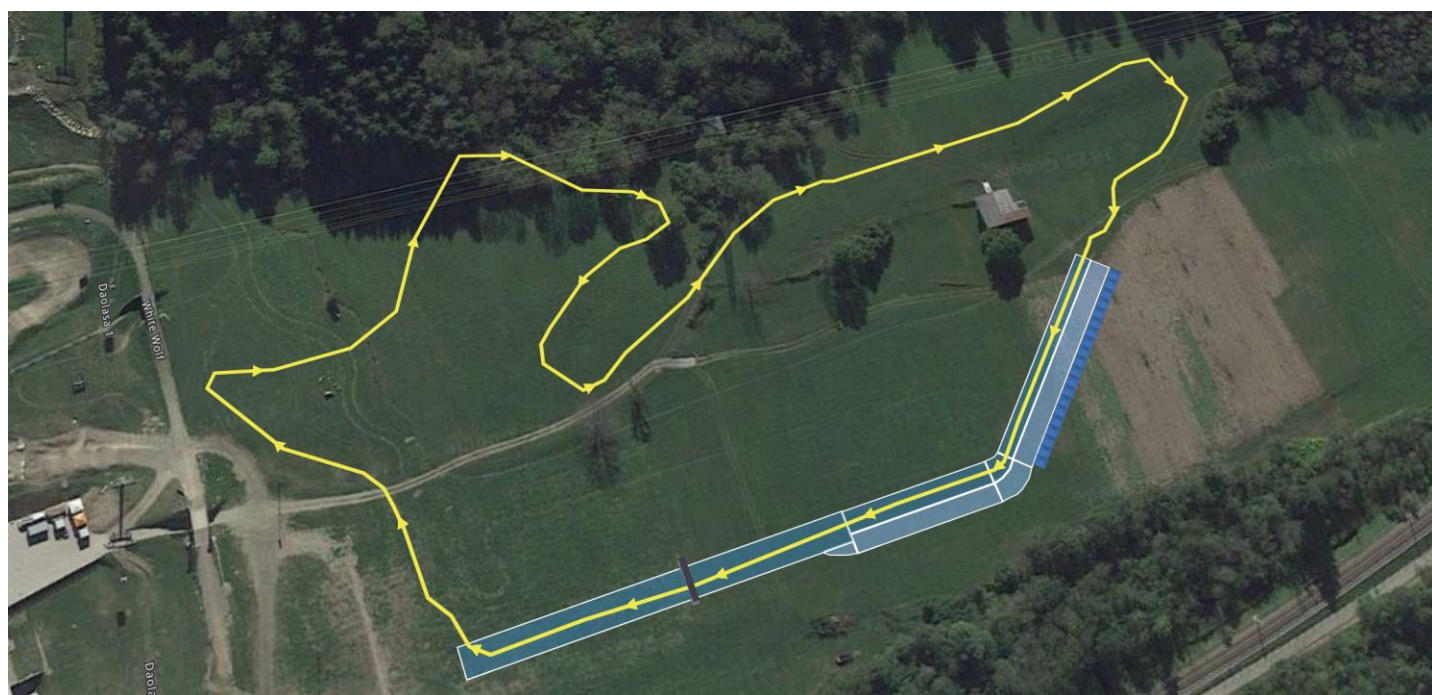

Please note: **World Series team bookings are managed directly by WBD Sports**. If you are part of a World Series team, **you do not need** to complete this form.

Teams will be welcomed upon arrival by our staff and guided to their designated spot within the paddock.

Teams must report to the Team Paddock entrance with receipt of booking and receipt of payment.

All teams must arrive at Team Paddock **by the end of day Wednesday 18th June**; any late arrivals will incur a €1000,00 fine. Teams are allowed to arrive from Monday, June 16th to Wednesday, June 18th (8am – 6pm).

If teams arrive after 18:00 on the days below (excluding Wednesday), they can park overnight in the town of Dimaro at the train station (3km from venue) or Marilleva 900 (3.8km from venue).

STRICTLY NO BIKE WASHING IN THE TEAM AREA & NO DRILLING INTO THE TARMAC.

04.2 ADDITIONAL TEAM PARKING

Teams will receive Val di Sole parking passes only for vehicles included in the team space that they have reserved. This vehicles can be parked inside the team area of the booked space. All other vehicles parked outside of this space will be removed.

Other vehicles that are not included in the reserved space can park in the parking area 1 km from the venue, without the need of any passes.

Then from here take the Trento-Malé-Mezzana line to Val di Sole, from where there are regular coach links to all the towns.</p> <p>The Trento Malé Mezzana station is about 200 m from Trento railway station, and this is where you get the narrow-gauge train that connects Trento to the Val di Sole. 06.5 MEDICAL AND CONCUSSION PROTOCOL

WBD & the UCI are committed to improving rider safety & ensuring that athletes taking part in our events receive the highest standard of medical care possible. One area where we want to ensure consistency across all MTB disciplines at our events is the identification of potential rider head injury / concussion events & the subsequent assessment & medical diagnosis of concussions where necessary.

The UCI have a concussion protocol & we will, in conjunction with the LOC appointed medical team, be applying this protocol across all disciplines during training & races. Any rider who has an incident which could result in a head injury / concussion & is then asked to undergo a concussion assessment by a member of the event medic team must comply with this request. Likewise, any rider or team manager who suspects a concussion should refer themselves or their athlete to the event medical team as soon as possible. A positive diagnosis of concussion by a medical professional may result in that athlete being withdrawn from competition.

It is the responsibility of all team staff and Riders to familiarise themselves with the signs and symptoms of a potential concussion. If they or their athlete display any symptoms, they are to present themselves to the on - site WBD medical liaison officer for assessment.

Any Rider who is asked by a race official to undergo a medical or concussion assessment by a Registered / Licensed Health Care Professional must comply.

Any Rider who fails or refuses a concussion assessment by a Registered / Licensed Health Care Professional during an event will be removed from the current training session or race.

They will be prohibited from further participation until cleared in writing by a Registered / Licensed Health Care Professional to resume such activity.

Should a concussion be confirmed by a Registered / Licensed Health Care Professional, the athlete is responsible for completing a "graduated return to activity" plan.

During all WBD events, medical staff may collect preliminary Rider injury and illness data, to monitor the magnitude of issues that occur. As part of a Rider's participation, this will include a Rider's medical data should any Rider sustain an injury (or illness) during an event.

No Rider will be identifiable at any stage during any collection of this data, and any data collected on a Rider will be always anonymized and kept strictly confidential.

The information gathered may be used by WBD to help guide and direct future Rider health and injury/illness prevention initiatives. A Rider does not need to do anything as part of this data collection
