#### Any non-returned transponder will incur a charge of 100 euros.

Award Ceremonies will take place at the podium stage within the finish bowl The presentations of each race will be organized for the top 3 riders in each category as soon as possible after the last finishing rider.

All riders must attend the podium as per applied rules.

- Member of an official UCI World Series Team or UCI Mountain Bike Team
- Current National Champion
- National Federation Quota
- Minimum Global ranking position

#### 03.2 RACE LICENCES

#### UCI World Cup

All riders must hold a valid (in date) UCI licence issued by their National Federation. Riders will be required to present their licences at rider confirmation.

Riders under the age of 18 must provide parental consent.



#### 03.9 TRAINING

TRAINING SCHEDULE Friday 4th July 09:00 – 18:30 : Training – All Riders

Official training will take place on **Friday 4th July** – full practice schedule will be released during the event week.

All riders and team staff must display their handlebar number during training sessions. As per the <u>2025 Enduro Rulebook</u> (Article 1.1.5), only Official UCI Enduro Teams will be provided team plates to allow team staff on course during practice only.

Race stages are closed during official training to all Riders but media and official Whoop UCI Enduro World Cup Team staff.

Any rider training without a plate or outside the official schedule will be disqualified.

#### 03.10 SHUTTLES AND LIFTS

All riders will get lift access for both practice and race.

Enduro: A dedicated LIFTs (<u>Bosco</u> + <u>Chalet</u>) are available for riders at the EDR competition. Opening times Wednesday till Sunday: 09.00 am UCI All Riders & Teams 09.00 pm closed

#### IMPORTANT SHUTTLE INFORMATION FOR PRACTICE DAYS

A specific mobility plan is planned for the venue during the event. As such all course and village accesses are subjected to restrictions. In order to ensure a safe event, all shuttle transfers from teams are strictly prohibited during the training and race days. No practice shuttle booking is required.

All riders and team members are provided with lift access.

Marshalls will be in place to ensure compliance. Penalties are applied up to & including DQ

#### 03.11 TIMING TRANSPONDER COLLECTION

Timing system: Chronorace

Timing transponders will be issued at rider confirmation.

All riders are responsible for the return of their transponder in the finish area. Any non-returned transponder will incur a charge of 100 euros.

Full face helmets and knee pads are mandatory during official training and race. Open face helmets can be worn during liaison stages/transitions.

Leader jerseys will be awarded to the series leader in UCI Enduro World Cup categories.

WBD and the LOC will measure paddocks onsite, and due to very restricted space anyone exceeding the maximum allowance will be charged by the LOC.

#### TEAM AREA RESERVATION by LOC

All UCI MTB Teams, World Cup Individuals and National Federations can reserve a paid space by filling out the request at BOOKING SPORT SERVICES (<u>https://lathuile.skiperformance.com/en/summer/store#/en/summer/buy?is\_promo=1&is\_promo\_offer=0&promo\_connector\_id=165</u>) no later than June 19th, 2025.

Once in the page each team should fill in their race code and shop for their services. Payment is available at the end of the process through final registration and check out. A confirmation e-mail should be received, listing the booked and paid services. #### WATER

Following the regulations for water conservation and anti waste water dispersion, bike washing is strictly prohibited in any other point of the venue. Water should be preserved at any point and waste water should be collected and securely transferred to a dedicated spot based on recycling plan.

Any non compliant behaviour will be charged €500 at each sanctioned occurring case.

#### CO2 Footprint reduction

#### 06.5 MEDICAL AND CONCUSSION PROTOCOL

WBD & the UCI are committed to improving rider safety & ensuring that athletes taking part in our events receive the highest standard of medical care possible. One area where we want to ensure consistency across all MTB disciplines at our events is the identification of potential rider head injury / concussion events & the subsequent assessment & medical diagnosis of concussions where necessary.

The UCI have a <u>concussion protocol</u> & we will, in conjunction with the LOC appointed medical team, be applying this protocol across all disciplines during training & races. Any rider who has an incident which could result in a head injury / concussion & is then asked to undergo a concussion assessment by a member of the event medic team must comply with this request. Likewise, any rider or team manager who suspects a concussion should refer themselves or their athlete to the event medical team as soon as possible. A positive diagnosis of concussion by a medical professional may result in that athlete being withdrawn from competition.

For full details of the UCI concussion protocol, the assessment process & the return to play process please follow this <u>link.</u>

It is the responsibility of all team staff and Riders to familiarise themselves with the signs and symptoms of a potential concussion. If they or their athlete display any symptoms, they are to present themselves to the on - site WBD medical liaison officer for assessment.

Any Rider who is asked by a race official to undergo a medical or concussion assessment by a Registered / Licensed Health Care Professional must comply.

Any Rider who fails or refuses a concussion assessment by a Registered / Licensed Health Care Professional during an event will be removed from the current training session or race. They will be prohibited from further participation until cleared in writing by a Registered / Licensed Health Care Professional to resume such activity.

Should a concussion be confirmed by a Registered / Licensed Health Care Professional, the athlete is responsible for completing a "graduated return to activity' plan.

During all WBD events, medical staff may collect preliminary Rider injury and illness data, to monitor the magnitude of issues that occur. As part of a Rider's participation, this will include a Rider's medical data should any Rider sustain an injury (or illness) during an event.

No Rider will be identifiable at any stage during any collection of this data, and any data collected on a Rider will be always anonymized and kept strictly confidential.

The information gathered may be used by WBD to help guide and direct future Rider health and injury/illness prevention initiatives. A Rider does not need to do anything as part of this data collection
