02.5. TEAM AND RIDER EVENT ACCREDITATION

Teams with a confirmed paddock reservation will receive accreditation-format lift passes (8 for Wildcard teams and UCI Teams, 5 for National Federations, and 5 for Private Teams).

If additional access is required, extra passes can be purchased at the Gondola at the following rates:

- 1-day pass: €20
- 3-day pass: €50
- 5-day pass: €75

Both the accreditation and the lift passes grant access to all lifts and competition venues.

03.13 FEED ZONES AND TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE ZONES (TAZ)

There will be one feed zone and two technical assistance zones on the course. Outside feeding and technical assistance is only permitted in these zones.

Accreditation or passes must be worn by helpers and mechanics in the feed and technical assistance zones, these will be handed over at rider confirmation to Team Managers or individual riders.

The main feed and technical zone is located just above the Start/Finish line approximately halfway around the lap and will be entered via a 'pit lane' as indicated below, and split into Elite teams, UCI Teams, National Federations and Individual riders.

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TEAM PADDOCK PROCEDURES

04.1 TEAM AREA ACCESS

The paddocks must be set up between Monday 7th 8 am and Tuesday 8th at 6pm.
By Wednesday 9th in the morning, all paddocks without exception must be set up to allow for the smooth circulation of vehicles.

Check-in Procedure:

All teams must report to the Race Office to collect their accreditations (location: Race Office Location), pay the €250 deposit, and only then proceed to the resort.

Arrival: Teams may arrive no later than 5:00 pm on July 8th.

Departure:

- Downhill area: From July 12, From 7:00 pm onwards, or later if the competition has not yet finished.
- Cross-country area: From July 13, From 7:00 pm onwards, or later if the competition has not yet finished.

Please note:

- It is strictly forbidden to drill holes or paint on the ground.
- Washing bikes in the paddock area is not allowed; the designated bike wash stations must be used.
- Vehicle movement within the paddock is prohibited during competition hours.
- The Andorran traffic code must be always respected.
- The upper area of the Bike Park will be closed throughout the entire competition. Riding bikes that are not officially accredited for the event in this area is strictly forbidden.
- Only accredited bikes will be allowed to circulate between the venues.

Failure to comply with the paddock regulations will result in the loss of the €250 deposit.

STRICTLY NO BIKE WASHING IN THE TEAM AREA & NO DRILLING INTO THE TARMAC.

PADDOCK FOOTPRINTS - PADDOCK A

Please note that WHOOP UCI MTB World Series Team paddock footprints must not exceed 200m2.

WBD and the LOC will measure paddocks onsite, and due to very restricted space anyone exceeding the maximum allowance will be charged by the LOC.

04.2 ADDITIONAL TEAM PARKING

The team parking area is located just outside the paddock zone. Circulation within the paddock will be limited during the day and strictly prohibited during qualification and finals hours.

To ensure the proper implementation of the competition's mobility plan, the accreditation system and the authority of the venue staff must be strictly respected. Any form of disrespect towards our team members will not be tolerated.

TEAM PADDOCK PROCEDURES

04.3 TEAM DE-RIG AND DEPARTURES

For DH teams, dismantling can take place on Saturday from the end of the races (not before 7 pm).
For XC teams, dismantling can take place on Sunday from the end of the races (not before 7 pm)

Paddock rules:

- It is strictly forbidden to drill holes or paint on the ground.
- Washing bikes in the paddock area is not allowed; the designated bike wash stations must be used.
- Vehicle movement within the paddock is prohibited during competition hours.
- The Andorran traffic code must be always respected.
- The upper area of the Bike Park will be closed throughout the entire competition. Riding bikes that are not officially accredited for the event in this area is strictly forbidden.
- Only accredited bikes will be allowed to circulate between the venues.

06.5 MEDICAL AND CONCUSSION PROTOCOL

WBD & the UCI are committed to improving rider safety & ensuring that athletes taking part in our events receive the highest standard of medical care possible. One area where we want to ensure consistency across all MTB disciplines at our events is the identification of potential rider head injury / concussion events & the subsequent assessment & medical diagnosis of concussions where necessary.

The UCI have a concussion protocol & we will, in conjunction with the LOC appointed medical team, be applying this protocol across all disciplines during training & races. Any rider who has an incident which could result in a head injury / concussion & is then asked to undergo a concussion assessment by a member of the event medic team must comply with this request. Likewise, any rider or team manager who suspects a concussion should refer themselves or their athlete to the event medical team as soon as possible. A positive diagnosis of concussion by a medical professional may result in that athlete being withdrawn from competition.

It is the responsibility of all team staff and Riders to familiarise themselves with the signs and symptoms of a potential concussion. If they or their athlete display any symptoms, they are to present themselves to the on - site WBD medical liaison officer for assessment.

Any Rider who is asked by a race official to undergo a medical or concussion assessment by a Registered / Licensed Health Care Professional must comply.

Any Rider who fails or refuses a concussion assessment by a Registered / Licensed Health Care Professional during an event will be removed from the current training session or race.

They will be prohibited from further participation until cleared in writing by a Registered / Licensed Health Care Professional to resume such activity.

Should a concussion be confirmed by a Registered / Licensed Health Care Professional, the athlete is responsible for completing a "graduated return to activity" plan.

During all WBD events, medical staff may collect preliminary Rider injury and illness data, to monitor the magnitude of issues that occur. As part of a Rider's participation, this will include a Rider's medical data should any Rider sustain an injury (or illness) during an event.

No Rider will be identifiable at any stage during any collection of this data, and any data collected on a Rider will be always anonymized and kept strictly confidential.

The information gathered may be used by WBD to help guide and direct future Rider health and injury/illness prevention initiatives. A Rider does not need to do anything as part of this data collection
